Section B

1. Activities reflecting the goals and objectives of the institution

To keep in pace with changing world, the college restructured the course pattern for UG and PG courses. The college encouraged the faculty to go for Refresher / Orientation courses and to apply for more projects.

2. New academic programmes initiated (UG and PG)

In the self-finance stream, three UG courses viz., B.Sc. (Bio-technology), B,Sc. (Information Technology) and B.Sc. (Electronics and Communication) and M.Phil. in Physics were started in this Academic Year.

3. Innovations in curricular design and transaction

To enhance the potentiality of students to face the stiff competition either in admission to Higher Educational Institutions or the job market, the entire course structure of UG and PG courses under the CBCS was revamped by the inclusion of Major Elective, Non-major elective and Skill-based elective papers. Also the students have the choice of choosing a number of courses provided as Certificate programmes.

4. Inter-disciplinary programmes started

Non-Major Elective papers and Skill-Based Elective papers cater to this aspect.

5. Examination reforms implemented

Provision for improvement examination is made for students of PG classes who were already awarded degree but scored between 50% to just less than 60%. The Academic Council gave a one-time permission from the academic year 2008-09 onwards for such students to sit for the improvement examinations in any 4 papers.
